

NOV. 13, 1967 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT
EXCEPT ALD. DAVID.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance presented Mr. S. M. Harrison who delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of the Oct. 23 meeting were read and approved.
3. The claim of S. M. Harrison for damages to trees on a lot owned by Mr. Harrison in 1958 was discussed. Ald. King moved to pay the \$300 asked by Mr. Harrison, Ald. Norton seconded and the motion was approved.
4. Ald. King announced that Oak St. had been designated an emergency crossing to the hospital to permit the L & N to use the Pine & Maple St. crossing for switching which is supposed to leave the downtown crossings open to traffic.
5. Ald. Woods said he had asked Supt. Owens to replace burned out lights at the rear of the water filtration plant and to correct the overflow of water from the reservoir on Brogdon Mtn.
6. Supt. Owens stated that he had discussed with Mr. J. L. Spink the annexation of Mr. Spink's property near the hospital.
7. Council, on motion of Ald. Norton, 2nd of Ald. King, voted to cooperate with the Gordon Co. Chamber of Commerce in their effort to secure air freight and passenger service for the community, by purchasing a "season" ticket for eight round trips to Atlanta Airport on Crest Air Lines.
8. Ald. Woods moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Norton and done.
