



JULY 24, 1967 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH MAYOR DICKINSON, ALD. DAVID AND NORTON PRESENT; ALD. KING & WOODS ABSENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of regular meeting of July 10 and called meeting of July 13 read and approved.
3. Ald. Norton moved to amend the ordinance of July 10 by changing "from Dr. Youman's office North" to "from the North side of Mrs. C. S. Jackson's drive way North to Line St." Ald. David seconded and the motion was passed.
4. Ald. David, Gordon Co. Civil Defense Director, expressed his gratitude to all who assisted in the recovery of the body of James Burchett, 19, from the Oostanaula River.
5. Council decided not to purchase the Addressograph equipment.
6. Robert A. Acree requested permission to repair the house at 113 McConnell Road condemned by the city on May 4. City Supt. Owens and Bldg. Inspector Bowman both stated that the house could not be repaired or remodeled to meet the minimum code standards. Mayor Dickinson told Mr. Acree he would like to grant his request, but in view of the opinions of Mr. Owens and Mr. Bowman, he could see no alternative except to remove the house or demolish it. Mr. Acree said he would move the house outside the city.
7. Ald. Norton moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. David and done.
