

FEB. 27, 1967 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH MAYOR DICKINSON, ALDERMEN DAVID & NORTON PRESENT, ALDERMEN KING AND WOODS ABSENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of Feb. 13 meeting read and approved.
3. Mayor Dickinson announced that Ald. Woods was in the VA hospital in Atlanta.
4. Ald. Norton said he did not believe that the City should participate in the payment of county tax officials salaries.
5. Ald. David discussed the possibility of an EOC on the property between N. Wall St. and the terminus of College St.
6. Bids opened on garbage truck cab and chassis with Prater Ford bidding \$4,239.00 and Roy Davis Chevy-Olds, \$4,937.34. Ald. Norton moved to purchase the Ford, Ald. David 2nd, voted & done.
7. Supt. Owens reported that the new fire truck would not clear the awning at front of fire hall and that Calhoun Sheet Metal would install a new one for \$250.00. Ald. Norton made a motion that the new awning be purchased, Ald. David 2nd, voted and passed.
8. Clerk read bill from L & N RR for Oak St. Crossing in the amount of \$1,738.61. Action deferred until March 13 meeting.
9. Delinquent taxes discussed and the clerk was instructed to collect them as soon as possible.
10. Ald. Norton moved to adjourn, Ald. David seconded and done.
