

JUNE 26, 1967 - REGULAR MEETING CITY COUNCIL, ALL PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance read Chapter 22 of Revelations.
2. Minutes of June 12 meeting read and approved.
3. Clerk read Mayor Dickinson's veto of Item 8 of June 12 meeting. After discussion, Ald. King made a motion to employ Lex Jolley and Co. as fiscal agent for the sewage treatment facilities. Ald. David seconded and the motion was voted on and passed.
4. Supt. Owens reported that Miss Elnora Harper had agreed to sell the city 18 Acres of land plus easements for 2 sewer mains and right of ingress and egress for \$40,000. Ald. Norton moved to accept the offer; Ald. David seconded the motion, voted on and passed unanimously.
5. Supt. Owens said Rev. John Bledsoe, pastor of the First Baptist Church, had contacted him in regard to letting the church cut a street thru city property on Woodland Drive. Council agreed to cooperate provided the subdivision developers would permit it.
6. Supt. Owens and Ald. King said they enjoyed the GMA convention in Atlanta June 18-20 and Mr. King added that the convention approved a resolution prohibiting striking by city employees and also favored a 1% local sales tax in spite of the vigorous opposition of Gov. Maddox.
7. Ald. King moved that a resolution banning angle parking on Court St. from River to Wall St. be forwarded the State Highway Dept. per their request. Ald. David seconded, voted & passed.
8. Ald. David announced that most merchants would close July 4 & 5. Clerk to check with Co. Comm. and work out closing for City Hall.
9. Frank Thomas of Frank Thomas & Co., Birmingham, Ala. arrived after the meeting was in progress and asked Mayor Dickinson if Council had reached a decision on the fiscal agent for the sewage facilities. The Mayor advised that Lex Jolley & Co. had been awarded this job. Mr. Thomas stated that he agreed the city had a legal right to accept or reject any and all bids, but he had submitted the only bid at the June 12 meeting. Mr. Thomas, obviously upset over losing this contract, walked out of the meeting.
10. Ald. Norton moved to adjourn, Ald. King 2nd and done.
