

MAY 22, 1967 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of May 8 meeting read and approved.
3. J. B. Sitton of S & W Auto Parts was present with reference to parking near his store. Council advised Mr. Sitton that no parking meters would be installed as yet and that an asphalt curb would be placed along the front of the former service station.
4. Ald. Norton presented a motion to install sidewalk and curb and gutter on the South side of E. Line St. from Hillcrest Dr. to Trammell St. Ald. King seconded and the motion was approved.
5. Ald. Woods said he would like to see the dumping of garbage and trash in Chandler Cemetery stopped. St. Supt. Kirby told Council that the chains the city had placed across the entrance were cut and stolen.
6. Ald. David offered a new Civil Defense ordinance and moved its adoption. Ald. Norton seconded and the motion was voted on and passed. (Ordinance attached.)
7. The city section for Oothcaloga St. was discussed.
8. Supt. Owens asked and received permission to request bids on 2 truck cabs and chassis and 1 flat dump body.
9. The clerk reminded council of Mrs. Beulah Holland's request for assistance on the debts incurred by her as a result of an accident on a street cut made by city forces. No action taken.
10. Mayor Dickinson said Frank Thomas had asked to appear at a subsequent meeting to further pursue the possibility of acting as fiscal agent for the city on the forthcoming bond issue for sewage treatment facilities. Clerk to request bids from Mr. Thomas and Lex Jolley.
11. Clerk instructed to continue to use all legal means to collect past due taxes.
12. Ald. Woods moved to adjourn; Ald. Norton 2nd and done.
