


APRIL 28, 1967 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY-COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION

1. Chairman Jack Holland called the meeting to order, then announced that the commission would elect officers and reorganize. The city members are Mr. Holland, 3 yrs., Al Head, 2 yrs. and Hoyt Edwards, 1 yr. County members are Marvin Taylor, 3 yrs., J. C. Maddox, 2 yrs. and Max Brannon, 1 yr.
Jack Holland nominated for chairman by J. C. Maddox, 2nd by Al Head.

There were no other nominees and Mr. Holland and Mr. Edwards, were re-elected.
2. Doug Hudson, Coosa Valley Area Planning and Dev. Comm. representative, presented several copies of the Neighborhood Analyses for Calhoun.
3. Max Brannon requested that the property at 705 Red Bud Road be re-zoned from R-2 to C*N. Mr. Maddox moved, Al. Head 2nd, that this be recommended to the City Council, voted and passed.
4. George W. Cox asked that the property on the North side of Hunt Drive adjacent to his apartment house be re-zoned from R-1 to R-2 to permit the construction of another apartment house. On motion of the secretary and second of Mr. Head, this was also approved and referred to the City Council.
5. The commission discussed re-zoning of the area West of L & N RR from Second Avenue to Oothcaloga St. from C-2 to C-1. Mr. Maddox moved that this also be referred to the City Council with the commission's request for approval. Mr. Brannon seconded and the motion was unanimously passed.
6. Secretary announced that the Zoning Board of Appeals had refused to permit a trailer to be moved to Harlan St.
7. Mr. Maddox moved to adjourn, Mr. Head 2nd; voted and passed.
