


SEPT. 25, 1967 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of Sept. 11 meeting read and approved.
3. Ald. Woods reported that Willard Cochran was concerned with surface water on his lot since the adjoining property owner had installed pipe across his lot. Supt. Owens said Mr. Cochran had been advised that the city would lay concrete pipe across his lot also, if he would pay the cost of the pipe.
4. Ald. Woods said he been approached with reference to extending the water main to the Sugar Valley Baptist Church. Supt. Owens advised that he had checked this, but the distance is too great.
5. Ald. David announced a briefing on the nation wide CD alert on Wednesday, Sept. 27.
6. Supt. Owens asked council to approve use of one fire truck, two firemen and enough policemen to handle traffic and parking at the Air Fair at Tom. B. David Field, Sunday, Oct. 1 from 2 to 5 P.M. Council approved use of truck and off duty men.
7. Ordinance unanimously approved to pay members of the City Board of Education \$25 each annually on motion of Ald. Norton, 2nd of Ald. King.
8. Clerk read letter from Dr. Byron H. Steele, secretary of the Gordon Co. Medical Society, calling attention to the air pollution resulting from burning trash in the city dump.
9. Ald. King moved that the city enter an agreement with the Georgia National Guard on procedures involved in calling troops to aid in the control of riots and other civil disorders. Seconded by Ald. Norton, voted on and passed.
10. Supt. Owens stated that Marvin L. Taylor had accepted appointment as negotiator on the Oothcaloga St. project (F-065-1(5)). Council approved.
11. Ald. Norton moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. King and done.
