

MARCH 13, 1967 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH MAYOR DICKINSON,  
ALD. KING, DAVID AND NORTON PRESENT, ALD. WOODS ABSENT.


1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of Feb. 27 meeting read and approved.
3. J. D. Anderson, Jr. present seeking information on relocation of a Oothcaloga St. (SR 53) thru his supermarket. Council unable to advise when construction is to begin.
4. Al Head, pres. of the Gordon Co. Chamber of Commerce, expressed his concern over the proposed 100 unit Holiday Inn at I-75 and Red Bud Rd. Supt. Owens estimated it would cost approx. \$20,000 to extend sanitary sewer service to the site. After discussion, Ald. David made a motion that the city write the proposed owner, Mr. Anthony La Porte of Cordele, a letter stating that the city will do everything possible to cooperate with him in the construction of this facility. Ald. King 2nd, voted and passed.
5. Ald. King announced the Fire Dept. would hold Open House from 1 to 5 PM on Sunday, March 19. Mr. King said two additional firemen were now on duty; then read a letter from Edward Reifsnnyder of Ga. Cumberland Academy suggesting the city use students of the academy as firemen. Ald. King moved that he be granted authority to negotiate, 2nd by Ald. David; voted and passed.
6. Ald. King heard in regard to the 34th Annual GMA Convention at the Marriott in Atlanta on June 18,19,20. Clerk to make reservations at the Marriott.
7. Mayor Dickinson heard with reference to Smitty's Beverage Store. He said that Mr. Smith did not have a large enough lot to comply with zoning regulations. Council agreed to re-zone the block and the block northeast of it from C-2 to C-1. Motion was by Ald. King with second from Ald. Norton.
8. Ald. David made a motion that the city purchase 35 Acres from Oothcaloga Industrial Development, Inc. for the Recreation Comm. for a total price of \$19,000 with the Rec. Comm. furnishing \$6,500. Ald. King 2nd, voted and passed.
9. Clerk presented bill from L & N RR for Oak St. crossing for \$1,738.61. Council instructed clerk not to pay this.
10. Ald. Norton moved to adjourn, Ald. David 2nd, voted and passed.
