

MARCH 27, 1967 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH MAYOR  
FRANK M. DICKINSON, ALD. KING AND DAVID PRESENT, ALD.  
NORTON AND WOODS ABSENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of March 13 meeting read and approved.
3. Ald. David asked about the bath house for the swimming pool on W. Line St. Supt. Owens said it would be started this week.
4. Ald. King announced that the city had employed a student at Ga. Cumberland Academy as a fireman at \$35 per week and he is furnishing his own uniforms.
5. Supt. Owens said he would like to send Jack Bell and M. J. West to the meter school at the Univ. of Fla. April 2-7 and Joe Rawls to the water pollution school at Gainesville, Ga. Council approved.
6. L & N RR bill for the Oak St. crossing read and discussed with Ald. King moving that the bill be paid. Ald. David 2nd, voted and passed.
7. An amendment to the Housing Authority cooperation agreement was approved on motion of Ald. King, 2nd of Ald. David.
8. The zoning ordinance was amended changing a portion of Hunt Drive from R-1 to R-2 and Red Bud Road from College to Nelson St. was changed from R-2 to C-2. The north side of Hunt Drive was re-zoned from Blvd. Hts. to the east property line of George W. Cox, et al.
9. Ald. David announced a Civil Defense meeting Monday, April 17 at the division offices of the State Highway Dept.
10. Clerk read parts of a letter from the State Highway Dept. reminding Council that Dec. 31, 1968 is the deadline for completion of revision of all traffic control devices so as to conform with those outlined in the "Georgia Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways".
11. Council approved re-submittal of request for federal funds '68 for extending the airport runway 500 ft.
12. Ald. King moved to adjourn, Ald. David 2nd, voted and passed.
