

JAN. 9, 1967 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of Dec. 12 meeting read and approved.
3. Mayor Dickinson administered the oath of office to re-elected Aldermen Tom. B. David and John T. Woods, Jr.
4. Certified results of the City Election of Dec. 14 accepted by Council on motion of Ald. King, seconded by Ald. Norton.
5. Ald. David moved to appoint Ald. King Mayor Pro-Tem, Ald. Norton 2nd, voted and passed.
6. Ald. David made motion to re-appoint Tom L. Shanahan City Atty., 2nd by Ald. Woods, Voted and passed.
7. Ald. King moved to grant all city employees a 10% pay increase effective Jan. 2. Ald. Norton seconded the motion which was voted on and unanimously passed.
8. Council agreed not to participate in the Chattanooga Times pro-motion.
9. Mayors' Day in Atlanta to be attended by all but Ald. David.
10. Mayor Dickinson re-appointed same committees for 1967.
11. Ald. King said the police dept. had 16 men and 8 cars on duty New Year's Eve. Mr. King reported everything ran smoothly and recommended the same procedure be followed in the future.
12. The Mayor commended Mr. David for the excellenct program for the dedication of the airport.
13. Ald. Woods expressed his gratitude fo all dept. heads for the manner in which they handled the city's business in '66.
14. Ald. David expressed his appreciation to the several city employees who participated in the airport dedication. Mr. David asked the Council to approve \$8,000 to \$10,000 for a hangar provided the County will match it. Ald. Norton made a motion to do this, 2nd by Ald. King voted and passed.
15. Mayor Dickinson said he had been approached by some property owners south of the city wishing to petition for annexation. The matter was discussed, but no definite action taken.
16. Resolution from the Housing Authority of the City of Calhoun read by Mayor Dickinson. Ald. King moved to approve, 2nd by Ald. David, voted and passed.
17. Letter from Mr. J. C. Boyd, Exec. Dir of the Housing Authority, about surface drainage. Council instructed Supt. Owens to furnish an estimate for PHA consideration.
18. Supt. Owens heard in the matter of garbage containers for the business district. Mr. Owens said these would cost \$227.75 each and we would need 36 of them. The garbage body to cost \$4,860. Council advised Mr. Owens to canvass the merchants to see if they're willing to purchase the 3 yd. containers with the city to maintain and replace at no cost to the merchants.
19. Ald. David moved to pay half the dues to Coosa Valley Area Plng. & Dev. Comm. Ald. Woods, 2nd, voted and passed.
20. Ald. Norton moved to approve the resolution from the City Board of Education for the Vocational Technical School. Ald. Woods, 2nd, voted and passed.
21. Ald. King made a motion to adopt the housing code of the Southern Bldg. Codes Congress. Ald. David 2nd, voted and passed.
22. Council agreed to appoint a Citizens Advisory Comm and Sub-Comm.
23. Ald. King moved to adjourn, Ald. Woods 2nd and done.
