

OCT. 9, 1967 - REGULAR MEETING CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT
EXCEPT ALD. KING.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance gave the invocation.
2. Minutes of Sept. 25 meeting and called meeting of Sept. 29 read and approved.
3. Petition of R. E. Robbins for re-zoning of his S. Wall St. property read and discussed. Clerk advised that the City-County Planning Comm. had recommended the change. Mr. & Mrs. Verlyn Hayes and Randolph Mincey, residents of the immediate neighborhood, demonstrated their interest, but did not protest the re-zoning. Ald. Norton moved the property be re-zoned from R-2 (residential) to C-2 (commercial). Ald. David seconded the motion which was voted on and passed.
4. Ald. Woods said garbage and trash was still being spilled on the streets leading to the city dump and that some residents are burning leaves. Mr. Woods asked that the public be notified thru the press in an effort to eliminate both practices.
5. Clerk asked Council's pleasure with regard to collection of a penalty for late payment of water and power bill by Cabin Crafts. Advised to collect same.
6. Council appointed Paul Shoffner, J. T. Woods, Jr., Tom B. David, W. R. Norton and A. J. King as city tax assessors and set Monday, Oct. 16 at 7:30 P. M. as "Gripe Night".
7. Mayor Dickinson welcomed JC's Dick Carr, J. C. Maddox and Leon Gresham to the meeting.
8. Ald. Woods moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. David and done.
