


OCT. 23, 1967 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT
EXCEPT ALD. JOHN T. WOODS, JR.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of Oct. 9 meeting read and approved.
3. Ald. David, CD Director, reported on the CD Exercise 67. Mr. David said the alert would begin at 9 A. M. on Oct. 24 and end on Nov. 1.
