

JULY 10, 1967 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH MAYOR DICKINSON,
ALD. DAVID, KING AND WOODS PRESENT. ALD. NORTON ABSENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of June 26 meeting read and approved.
3. Ald. Woods said he would like to increase the salaries of key men and give them some time off on Sat. He and Supt. Owens to work together on a plan to accomplish this.
4. Ald. David asked Chief Roberts if he could stop the throwing of beer cans on bank parking lot on weekends.
5. Ald. David said J. D. Anderson, Jr. was concerned about the status of SR 53. Supt. Owens said he believed it would be let to contract soon and the plans had not been changed.
6. Ald. David received Council approval to have two to four men attend a Civil Defense rescue course in Cartersville July 29-30.
7. Ald. King offered a resolution in support of all GMA resolutions approved at the convention and requested the clerk to notify the GMA, Lt. Gov. Smith and Rep. Tom Shanahan. Ald. Woods seconded and the resolution was approved.
8. Ald. King moved to eliminate parking on the East side of Piedmont St. from Dr. Youmans' office north to Line St. Motion seconded by Ald. Woods, voted and passed.
9. Supt. Owens announced that the city attorney was preparing the deed for the purchase of Miss Elnora Harper's property for the sewage treatment plant site.
10. Clerk heard in the matter of purchasing Addressograph equipment. It was decided not to purchase at the present time.
11. Ald. King recommended that an ad be placed in the Calhoun Times advising dog owners that their pets must be kept in their own yards. Council approved.
12. Ald. David moved to adjourn, Ald. Woods 2nd and done.
