

MAY 8, 1967 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH MAYOR DICKINSON,
ALD, KING, DAVID & WOODS PRESENT; ALD. NORTON ABSENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of April 24 meeting read and approved.
3. Clerk advised that Mrs. Beulah Holland had reported expenses not covered by insurance of \$1,714.14. Mayor Dickinson said he wanted all the aldermen present before taking any action on this.
4. Ald. Woods said he had received complaints that Central Electric of Rome and others were installing and repairing electric motors without being licensed to do this.
5. Supt. Owens heard in the matter of purchasing a new Ford 3500 Diesel Tractor with Back Hoe and Loader. He said King Ford Tractor Co. had offered one at 5% above wholesale cost, i.e. \$7593.39. Ald. David made the motion to buy, Ald. King 2nd, voted and passed.
6. Council instructed Supt. Owens to proceed with the condemnation of sub-standard dwellings and buildings.
7. Supt. Owens advised that 73 minimums had been signed for water on the Red Bud Road.
8. *Neighborhood Analyses Adopted.*
8. Fire Chief Hyde announced that a representative of the Southeastern Underwriters Assn. had inspected the fire fighting equipment and water supply of the city and a report should be in soon.
9. No one appeared in opposition to the re-zoning of Red Bud Rd. between College St. and Nelson St. Council declared this section officially re-zoned from R-2 to C-2.
10. Ald. King moved to adjourn, Ald. Woods seconded and done.
