

APRIL 22, 1968 - REGULAR MEETING CITY COUNCIL, ALL MEMBERS PRESENT.

1. Ald. David delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of April 8 meeting read and approved.
3. Ald. Head introduced Mr. & Mrs. Dave Goodland. Mr. Goodland and J. C. Maddox were present representing the Goodyear Tire & Rubber Co. Mr. Maddox told Council that Goodyear was concerned over the City's high electric rates. Mayor Dickinson appointed Ald. Woods, Ald. Head, Supt. Owens and the City Clerk as a committee to study the problem and recommend solution.
4. Ald. Holland heard with reference to vacancies on the City-County Planning Commission. No action.
5. Ald. Head asked if any progress had been made toward the proposed parking lot east of the L & N RR between Court & Oothcaloga Sts. The clerk reported that Supt. E. H. Civils and Div. Traffic Mgr. Wallace Wathen of the L & N had come by the City Hall and suggested deferring action on this until their new lease with the state has been signed.
6. Ald. Head called for a vote on the application for a package malt beverage license of Donald E. Mealor at a Red Bud Rd. address. Mr. John W. Reese, a resident of Devondwood Dr. requested Council to deny the license and a petition in opposition to the granting of the license was presented with 34 signatures. Ald. Holland moved that the license be issued subject to approval, by the Council, of the building; Ald. Woods 2nd the motion. The vote was Holland and Woods for, David and Head opposed. Mayor Dickinson broke the tie by voting against issuance of the license.
7. Supt. Owens said a bulldozer was needed at the city dump. Council instructed Mr. Owens to get price quotations and present at the next meeting.
8. Supt. Owens called attention to the open sewer between Fain & Line Sts. running west from Pisgah Way. No action.
9. Ald. David made a motion that the Mayor execute amendment No. 1 to the Grant Agreement between the FAA and the city and county. (The purpose of the amendment is to restore the name of Gordon County to the grant agreement as co-sponsor with the city.) Ald. Woods seconded the motion, which was voted on and passed.
10. Ald. Woods said the hedge should be cut at the intersection of Piedmont and Hicks Sts.
11. Clerk presented petition of Mrs. Eunice M. Russell for annexation of her property to the city. Approved on motion of Ald. Woods, 2nd of Ald. Holland.
12. Billy Hughey requested Council approval of his offer to purchase Calhoun Cab Co. from Mack Graham, present licensee. Ald. Head, license comm. chairman, to investigate.
13. Ald. David moved to adjourn; 2nd by Ald. Woods and done.
