


DEC. 9, 1968 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation and congratulated the Council for a fine record during the year.
2. Minutes of Nov. 25 meeting read and approved.
3. After discussion, Ald. Holland moved to relocate portions of Pine St. and the Old Rome Rd. near Astro Dye. Ald. Woods 2nd and the motion was approved.
4. Ald. Head announced that he was moving to Atlanta and this would be his last meeting. Mr. Head read a farewell letter and Mayor Dickinson ordered it spread upon the minutes of this session.
5. Ald. Woods inquired as to progress being made on the extension of N. King St. Discussion followed.
6. Ald. David said Mr. W. A. Shirley of a Calhoun Avenue address had complained to him that the sidewalk needed some attention. Supt. Owens said this would be done.
