


SEPT. 23, 1968 - REGULAR MEETING CITY COUNCIL, ALL MEMBERS PRESENT

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of Sept. 9 meeting read and approved.
3. Ald. David said Elizabeth Steele denied that she was operating a beauty shop in her home and should not be charged the commercial rate for power. Determination to be made following investigation.
4. Ald. David heard with reference to the clerk attending the Election Code Workshop being held in Rome in conjunction with the Seventh District GMA meeting. Clerk to attend.
5. Everett DeFoor, Comm. of Roads & Revenues, advised Council that he had no objections to the making of water taps on county roads, but he must insist that the roads be returned to their original condition. The Council and Comm. DeFoor agreed for NW Ga. Paving Co. to make the repairs to the paved streets and roads. Supt. Owens to ascertain cost of repairs, notify the clerk and the cost of outside city taps to be increased accordingly.
6. Ald. Head announced that his committee met with the manufacturers on Industrial Blvd. and they appeared receptive to the city's plans for handling their sanitary sewage.
7. Ald. Holland heard in regard to the proposed parking lot on Park Avenue between Court and Oothcaloga Sts. State Rep. Tom Shanahan to present city's plan before the State Properties Control Commission meeting in Atlanta on Oct. 22.
8. Council discussed the tax levy for 1968. Clerk to present figures and council to set rate at Oct. 14 meeting.
9. Ald. Woods made the motion to accept the petition of Prater Ford for annexation of their property on the West side of S. Wall St. across from their agency property. Ald. David 2nd, voted on and passed.
10. The clerk read proposals from S & W Exterminating Co. on the City Hall. Council to consider and act at future date.
11. Ald. David moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Woods and done.
