

APRIL 8, 1968 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of March 25 meeting read and approved.
3. Ald. Holland reported that Roy Chattam was working on the petition to curb and gutter McConnell Road.
4. Ald. Holland said W. C. Burdette of the Raymond King Co. had been engaged to alter the plans for the jail by the City-Co. Jail Committee.
5. Ald. Holland moved that Section 6.2 of the Zoning Ordinance be amended to permit the City Council to classify as to districts. Ald. Head seconded the motion; voted on and passed.
6. Ald. Holland stated that sale of the Civic Center would necessitate building or otherwise providing an office for the offices of the City Supt. of Schools and personnel of his office. Discussion followed, no action.
7. Ald. Head moved to grant M. J. Gallman and Lee Roy Wilson license to operate a pawn shop and record shop on Park Ave. Ald. Holland 2nd, voted on and passed.
8. Ald. Head heard with reference to application of Donald E. Mealor for package malt beverage license on Red Bud Road. Council agreed to advertise application prior to voting.
9. Ald. David requested placement of recreation director and deputy on city retirement program. Council agreed.
10. Ald. Head's motion to sell the Civic Center bldg. and lot to the Calhoun National Bank for \$60,000.00 received a 2nd from Ald. Holland and unanimous approval of Council.
11. David Acree explained to Council that he had state approval for a 75 bed nursing home, but must have sanitary sewage service provided by the city. Mr. Acree admitted that the proposed bldg. site was outside the corporate limits of the city. Council advised Mr. Acree he would be notified if the city could assist him.
12. On motion of Ald. David, with 2nd from Ald. Holland, property of the following was annexed to the city by petition: S. L. Shepherd, Raymond F. King, Austin W. Richards, J. D. Meadows, Jr., C. M. Jones, Jo Thomas and Mrs. P. H. Gazaway, Mrs. Hugh Amos, Mrs. J. B. Moore and Mrs. Genelle Van Buskirk.
13. Ald. David moved to lease the lot near the airport to Southern Bell Tel & Tel Co as per agreement attached; 2nd by Ald. Head, voted on and approved.
14. Ald. Head moved to adjourn; Ald. David 2nd and done.
