

JULY 22, 1968 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of regular meeting of July 8 and called meeting of July 18 read and approved.
3. Council approved request of Civil Defense Director Tom David for two men to attend Radiological Monitor's Course in Atlanta August 12-17.
4. Ald. Holland reported that his committee had reached a decision and it is that any employee who resigns his position thereby forfeits all retirement, seniority and vacation benefits heretofore accrued. Mr. Holland moved that this be adopted as city policy, 2nd by Ald. Head, voted on and passed.
5. Ald. Holland heard with reference to the opening of a subdivision street by the city. Council agreed that the subdivision developer(s) must open and improve all streets.
6. Supt. Owens said officials of Astro Dye had requested the relocation of the street on the SE side of their property. Council approved provided other property owners agree.
7. Supt. Owens reported he had been contacted by a group planning to build a motel and shopping center on 20 acres of land at SR 53 & I-75 if city sewer service can be made available.
8. On motion of Ald. David and 2nd of Ald. Woods, the property of Harold Kenneth Parks on the South side of West May St. was accepted into the city, provided it is contiguous to property now in the city.
9. Ald. Woods announced that Herbert Wilson, an employee in the electric dept., was back at work Monday after accidentally receiving a severe electrical shock while at work Thursday AM.
10. Council agreed to hold the next meeting on Aug. 5 since the annual convention of the Ga. Municipal Assn. is on Aug. 11-13 and most plan to attend.
11. Ald. David moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Woods and done.
