

NOV. 25, 1968-REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.


1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of Nov. 11 meeting read and approved.
3. On motion of Ald. David, with a second from Ald. Head, the Council voted to cancel the meeting scheduled for Dec. 23, 1968.
4. Ald. David reported on the meeting with FAA officials in Atlanta on Nov. 22.
5. Council agreed to cooperate with developers in the extension of sanitary sewer service to a proposed motel and shopping center at SR 53 and I-75.
6. Ald. Woods moved that city employees be given the same Christmas bonus as in 1967. Ald. David 2nd, voted on and passed.
7. Ald. Head said Multi-Vision in Dalton is the only company still interested in cable TV for Calhoun.
8. Supt. Owens said he and J. C. Maddox were experiencing no difficulty in getting easements signed to extend sewer mains to Industrial Blvd.
9. On motion of Ald. Holland, 2nd of Ald. Woods, the property of James C. Boyd on West Drive, W. H. Garren Estate on US 41 S and Belmont Baptist Church were annexed by petition.
10. Ald. David moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Head and done.
