


MARCH 11, 1968 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of Feb. 26 meeting read and approved.
3. Mr. J. B. Tullis, an engineer with Southern Bell Tel & Tel Co, read a letter from his company offering to purchase a lot from the city for \$1,000 or lease it for \$150 annually. Ald. David made a motion to lease a 50' x 100' lot immediately north of the airport entrance for a period of ten years for \$240 per year with an option to renew the lease for a like period. Ald. Head seconded, and the motion was approved without dissent.
4. Ald. Head brought the matter of two beer applications to the floor. Ald. David moved to table the application of Donald E. Meador; 2nd by Ald. Head and done. Ald. Head then moved to grant a package license to Jerry Clark, dba Little Giant Food Store. Ald. Holland seconded. Ald. Head and Holland voted for issuance of license to Mr. Clark, Ald. David and Woods and Mayor Dickinson voted against and the motion failed to pass.
5. Ald. Holland recommended the installation of parking meters at Brown-Wood Barber Shop contingent upon approval of the property owner, Mr. A. S. Holcomb.
6. Ald. David heard with reference to construction of a recreation bldg. and a city-county jail. Discussed, no action taken.
7. Council discussed making a parking lot of the park between Oothcaloga & Court Sts., Park avenue and the railroad. Clerk to write Supt. E. H. Civils of L & N RR for permission.
8. Ald. David offered a motion that the city convey title to approx. 7 acres of land to the Georgia Education Authorities (Schools) for the East Side Elementary School. Ald. Woods, seconded, voted on and passed.
9. Supt. Owens reported that the equipment at the city dump was inadequate to handle the large volume of garbage and suggested that Council consider purchasing a dozer or limiting use of the dump.
10. Ald. David moved to adjourn; Ald. Woods 2nd and done.
