

AUG. 5, 1968 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL, ALL PRESENT.

1. Mayor Dickinson delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of July 22 meeting read and approved.
3. Clerk reported that the City-County Planning Comm. had recommended re-zoning from R-1 to R-2 a lot owned by Dick Tribble on Hunt Dr. George W. Cox and George C. Mashburn propose to build an apartment house on this lot which is directly across the street from two apartment houses now owned by Mr. Cox. Council ordered the proposed amendment properly advertised and a public hearing to be held at the August 26 meeting of the Council.
4. Ald. Woods heard with reference to adding one lane on N. Wall St. for traffic making left turns into A & W Root Beer drive in. Supt Owens to contact State Highway Dept.
5. Ald. Woods said the garbage situation had improved. Mayor Dickinson asked how many garbage containers had been placed in service. Supt. Owens replied that a total of 12 had been ordered, but only 8 had been delivered and all were in use. Ald. Head exhibited several photos he had made of paper and trash in the alley off Harlan St. Council instructed the police and fire chiefs to show the photos to the downtown merchants and seek their cooperation in alleviating this condition.
6. Ald. Holland inquired as to progress made on traffic flow at the shopping center. Supt. Owens said he had not had time to work on this.
7. Ald. Woods made a motion that all electricity be billed at commercial rates to residential users with commercial enterprise in their homes, except when separate meter is used. Ald. David 2nd the motion and it was unanimously approved.
8. Ald. David moved to adjourn; 2nd by Ald. Woods and done.
