

MAY 13, 1968 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH MAYOR DICKINSON,
ALDERMEN DAVID, HEAD AND WOODS PRESENT. ALD. HOLLAND ABSENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of regular meeting of April 22 and called meeting of May 3 read and approved.
3. John W. Corley, president of Wellco Carpet Corp., asked Council to extend water main to location of new plant on US 41 South, across from the airport. He agreed to use city power, if available. Supt. Owens estimated the cost of extending 8" water main to the site to be \$10,000.
4. Mr. J. C. Boyd, Executive Director of the Calhoun Housing Authority, expressed interest in the proposed paving of a sidewalk on the West side of McConnell Road. Mr. Boyd also requested improving the intersection at Buena Vista and Meadow Lane and discussed renewal of the "Workable Program for Community Improvement" with Council. It was agreed that the city would renew the "Workable Program".
5. Ald. Woods said the streets near the city dump were still being littered with trash. Mayor Dickinson asked Ald. David to instruct the police to make court cases against unauthorized persons using the dump and littering the streets.
6. Mayor Dickinson instructed Supt. Owens to have the traffic lanes repainted at Line & N. Wall Sts.
7. Supt. Owens presented price quotations on a bulldozer for the city dump from Yancey Bros. (Caterpillar), Tri State Tractor (International) and Southern Equipment (Euclid).
8. Supt. Owens said the State Highway Dept. would not approve the installation of a traffic light at S. Wall & Peters Sts., but had submitted a sketch suggesting the best method for facilitating the flow of traffic at this intersection.
9. Council agreed to make appointments to the planning commission as soon as qualified men will accept.
10. Ald. David moved to adjourn; 2nd by Ald. Head and done.
