


FEBRUARY 10, 1964 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT EXCEPT ALD. J. T. WOODS, JR. WHO HAS MUMPS.

1. Chaplain Lance had Rev. Carl Bolt, pastor of New Echota Methodist Church, deliver the invocation.
2. Minutes of Jan. 28 meeting read and approved.
3. Ald. Norton made motion, 2nd by Ald. King, to pay \$50.00 for damage to Jesse J. Pilcher's automobile. Motion carried.
4. Rev. Howard Crowe, pastor of South Calhoun Baptist Church, and Hugh Dell West, acting as a committee from the church, proposed selling the church to the city to be used as a public library. Mayor Dickinson appointed Ald. David to study feasibility of this proposal and report his findings to council.
5. Clerk announced that Calhoun and Gordon County had this date set a record. 333 pints of blood were collected by the Red Cross from local donors thereby saving the county's blood program.
6. Members of the City Board of Education and Supt. Gus Gate and members of the Calhoun Recreation Commission and Director Bill Bearden present seeking support of council for \$75,000 to \$100,000 with which to enlarge present gym and remodel old armory. Mayor Dickinson indicated his approval, but wished to study proposal prior to calling for a bond issue.
7. Olin Bagley and Raymond Ross asked council to annex house and lot belonging to Jack E. Fain, James P. Hammtree's house and lot, Olin Bagley's house and lot and lot only of Raymond Ross. Ald. King made a motion to accept this property. This motion seconded by Ald. David, but when it became known that there was no street in the city leading to this property, Ald. King amended his motion making acceptance contingent upon favorable report of Supt. Owens. Ald. David agreed and Mayor Dickinson instructed Supt. Owens to look into the matter and make his recommendation at a subsequent meeting.
8. The proposal of Fletcher Bros. to exchange an open account for \$5400.00 for the same amount of 6% debenture bonds was not acted upon.
9. Council agreed to pay Rome engineering firm of Williams, Sweitzer and Barnum \$525.00 for plat of Echota Cotton Mills property from funds of Chandler Cemetery.
10. Ald. King moved to adjourn, seconded by Ald. David and done.
