

MAY 11, 1964 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance opened the meeting with scripture reading and prayer.

2. Minutes of regular meeting of April 27 and called meeting of May 4 read and approved.

3. Ald. David read a resolution and contract and made a motion to adopt the resolution and enter into a contract with Gordon Co. to build an airport with state and federal aid. Ald. Norton seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

4. Messrs. Vern Kuhlman, Alton McDaniel, Raymond King were present expressing their continued interest in obtaining fire protection on Industrial Blvd. Ald. David reported that Mr. Cecil Jones of Southeastern Underwriters Assn. said the city could respond to fire calls from industry within three miles of fire station, but only with the old Ford pumper and on a temporary basis. After discussion, Mayor Dickinson appointed Ald. King to work with the industrial group to seek a satisfactory solution.

5. The Gordon Co. Chamber of Commerce and the Calhoun Junior C of C presented resolutions asking council to approve the proposed airstrip. Following the reading of these resolutions, Mayor Dickinson signed the contract and the aldermen and the mayor signed the resolution. Construction of the airport is now contingent upon funds being made available by the Federal Aviation Agency.

6. Mathew Chattam asked council to work out some way for him to use the garbage dump before the usual hour to open. Ald. Norton to advise in a few days.

7. Mathew Chattam requested permission to move a house from one lot to another, but was told the house could not be moved unless it met building code requirements.

8. Ald. King moved to allow free parking from May 16 thru May 30 by covering meters, Ald. Woods seconded the motion and it passed. Council instructed Police Chief Roberts to issue tickets for all parking violations except overtime parking.

9. Ald. Woods said Dixie Belle Mills had displayed no further interest in the National Guard property for parking purposes.

10. Supt. Owens recommended that Garren Construction Co. do the concrete work on the Negro swimming pool and the city buy the materials and install the filters. Council approved.

11. Supt. Owens heard with reference to charging a fee for using the garbage dump. He and Ald. Norton to make recommendation to council.

12. Ald. King moved the adoption of a resolution asking restoration of the original language in the proposed new Constitution with reference to gasoline tax rebates. This would permit the state to make grants to municipalities. Council approved.


