

JUNE 8, 1964 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT EXCEPT ALD. J. T. WOODS, JR. WHO WAS ATTENDING NATIONAL GUARD CAMP.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of regular meeting of May 25 read and approved.
3. Council discussed levying a sewer service charge by August 1, 1964 and instructed Supt. Owens and the City Clerk to determine what other cities are charging and so advise council.
4. City School Supt. Gus Cate reported he needed an additional amount of some \$13,600.00 to get through the school year. This request OK'd by Council. (Amount of \$13,626.71 actually given City Board for a total of \$86,626.71 for year.)
5. Supt. Cate discussed next year's school budget with Council and said more money than ever before would be required by the city schools next term.
6. Ald. King made a motion to pay policemen and firemen for the same holidays as other city employees are paid for. Ald. David seconded the motion which was passed.
7. City Supt. James Owens told Council he had two petitions requesting water. Six signers on Beamer Road dated June 1 and eleven on Herrington Bend Road dated June 6. Council suggested they be filed for handling next spring.
8. Supt. Owens said the City was in need of a new back hoe and three trucks should be replaced as soon as possible. Discussed - no action.
9. Ald. King heard in the matter of erecting a screen or fence between the property of Raymond Bagwell and the Negro swimming pool. No action taken.
10. Ald. David suggested, and Council agreed, that Clark Insurance Agency share equally with other agents in the city's insurance on the anniversary date of the policy.
11. Clerk announced that the 31st Annual Convention of the Georgia Municipal Convention would be held June 21, 22, and 23 at the Biltmore Hotel in Atlanta.
12. Ald. King gave a report on the Fire Defense Workshop held at the Coosa Country Club in Rome on May 27.
13. Ald. David moved to adjourn, Ald. Norton seconded the motion and the meeting was declared adjourned by Mayor Dickinson.
