

MAY 4, 1964 - CALLED MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT EXCEPT ALD. NORTON.

1. This meeting called to discuss proposed airstrip for Calhoun and Gordon County. Those present included Mr. John Bennett, State Dept. of Industry & Trade, Aviation Div., Mr. Gordon Moss, Engr. with the Federal Aviation Agency, Mr. Paul Williams, of the Rome Engineering firm of Williams, Sweitzer and Barnum, Mr. Troy Causby, Gordon Co. representative to the General Assbly. of Ga., Dr. Winfred Gray, county member of the airport committee, Mr. Everett Deffoor, commissioner elect of roads and revenues of Gordon Co., City Supt. James Owens, City Atty. J. C. Maddox, Messrs. E. C. Pate, Philip David Lynch, Ed Duvall and Ed Thomason.

2. Mayor Dickinson opened the meeting and turned it over to Ald. Tom David who called on Mr. Bennett who told of the interest other towns and cities in Ga. have shown in constructing airstrips with federal and state aid. Mr. Lynch spoke in favor of building this facility and Mr. Moss and Mr. Williams explained some of the features of the strip. Total cost of the airstrip is to be \$136,500, with the city's share to be \$21,625, but it was pointed out by Mr. Williams that the access road could be omitted for the present, thereby reducing the cost to the city by \$4,000. No action was taken at this meeting by council.


3. Supt. Owens showed council plans for the Negro Swimming Pool and was advised to get further information on some items in question.

4. No further business, the meeting was adjourned.
