


OCTOBER 12, 1964 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH MAYOR DICKINSON, ALDERMEN NORTON AND WOODS PRESENT; ALDERMEN DAVID AND KING ABSENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of Sept. 28 meeting read and approved.
3. Application for Malt Beverage License of W. A. Prater postponed until Oct. 12 meeting due to absence of Ald. King, chairman of the license committee.
4. Ald. Woods heard in the matter of Mr. C. W. Barrett having two water taps and being charged three minimums. Decided to follow usual procedure and continue to charge three minimums.
5. City Attorney J. C. Maddox said it would be necessary to pass an ordinance specifying the rate of interest the City School Bonds shall bear as well as providing for the place of payment of principal and interest, and the levying of taxes to retire these bonds. Bond election held on July 29, 1964. Ald. Norton moved the passage of such an ordinance, seconded by Ald. Woods and passed unanimously.
6. Supt. Owens told Council that he believed the City should have a sound retirement plan for its employees. Mayor Dickinson told Mr. Owens and Mr. Maddox to come up with a plan for the Council's consideration.
7. Supt. Owens heard in regard to converting the South Park into a parking lot. No action taken.
8. Mr. Maddox said the L & N Railroad had advised they would take measures to stop the blocking of crossings.
9. Supt. Owens informed Council that he had erected a blinker signal facing Park Avenue at Court St.
10. City Clerk reported that Mrs. Ross (Beulah) Holland had advised him that she had incurred physical injury to her back and damage to her automobile as a result of an accident caused by a ditch on Hunt Drive left by a city crew making a water tap at George Cox' apartment house. Council to consider the matter.
11. Police Chief Roberts was instructed to handle Hallowe'en as last year-for children below sixth grade. Any other trick or treaters not allowed.
12. Council discussed status of SR 53, (Oothcaloga St.), and decided to write State Highway Dept. requesting early letting of contract to improve this artery.
13. Ald. Norton moved, Ald. Woods seconded, to adjourn. Motion passed and done.
