

Calhoun, Georgia
July 23, 1956

City council met in regular session at the City Hall at 7:30 pm with all members present.

Meeting was opened with prayer by Mayor Lawrence.

Sequoyah Garden Club submitted a letter recommending to the city that they have the property owners clean out the underbrush, trees and shrubs so ^{not} to obstruct the vision of the automobile drivers.

A letter from the Clark Hill Power Project was read, stating that they had given the City until August 6, 1956 to act on the power contract now in question.

Mayor Lawrence reported that all material at the First Federal Savings and Loan Association ~~XXX~~ ^{has} been gathered together and sent to a law firm in Rome representing the Kansas City ~~XXXXX~~ ^{title} for further action.

The contract between the City of Calhoun and Jack Johnson was read and discussed. Mr. David made a motion to accept the contract seconded by Mr. Edwards voted on and passed.

The contract between the City of Calhoun and Mr. W. D. Putnam was read and discussed. Mr. David made a motion to accept the contract seconded by Mr. Edwards voted on and passed.

The application of Mr. Irvin Kiker for a job with the city was read at this time. The application was placed on file as no job was open at this time.

Mr. Dickinson made a motion to require all radio stations to get a permit from the city before locating and opening for business. This motion seconded by Mr. Woods voted on and passed.

Sewerage on Happy Top discussed. Mayor Lawrence stated that he had informed Mr. Neal to come before the Council for a discussion of this problem.


Mr. Edwards stated that he would like to see the following taken care of: Sidewalks over town needed repairing when money available; informed Police to stay after cars with loud mufflers; Erect new red light at the corner of Line and North Wall; erect stop sign at railroad approach in front of S. J. Dobson Implement Company; place stop sign at intersection of Harlan and Line Streets;.

Mr. Edwards made a motion to accept the bond of Velvetone Mills Inc., and refund the hundred dollars deposit they have up for lights and water.

A petition to pave Hunts Drive was read at this time. Action for this petition was tabled for the time being.

Mr. David made a motion to require Atlanta ^{EAS Light Co.} ~~Natural Gas~~ company to sign a permit to do damage to the streets. Bill will be sent to the gas company at a later date. Seconded by Mr. Edwards voted on and passed.

Mr. Edwards made a motion to adjourn as there was no other business to come before the council at this time. Seconded by Mr. Dickinson voted on and passed.
