

October 8, 1956
Calhoun, Georgia

City Council met in regular session at the City Hall at 7:30 pm .

Mayor Lawrence was absent from the meeting to fill an speaking engagement at the Jaycee meeting.

Mayor protem Hoyt Edwards opened the meeting with prayer.

Minutes of the previous meeting read and adopted.

Mr. ^{Dickinson} Woods reported that the parking lot situation on Park Ave. had been worked out and would be taken care of as soon as possible.

The City Council notified Chief Hayes to instruct the property owners who owned lots causing a fire hazard to clean them up as soon as possible. A few of these pointed out were the Hughey place on South Wall, Herrington house on North Wall and others.

Mr. Woods made a motion to run a thirty dollar ad in the local paper notifying the people of Fire Prevention Week. This motion was seconded by Mr. David voted on and passed.

Mr. Dickinson stated to the council that the Sanfax Company had given him some prices on trash cans for corners in the city. Stated he was passing these on to the council. A 34" high can would cost \$ 37.50

Mr. John Moore Requested that a fence be erected between the Civic Center and the Methodist Parsonage. After discussion , no action taken.

Mr. Clyde Evans requested that the sidewalk in front of his new store be repaired. After discussion the council agreed to patch the hole in front of the store and wait until later to make the major change needed to fix properly.

Edwards--- stated that he had informed the property owners on Henderson Bend Road that if they would advance the money the city would run water to them and pay them back as taps were made.

A petition from the property owners on Fite's Bend Road ^{Requesting water} was read at this time. After discussion no action taken.

The city clerk brought before the council the tax return of Mr. Earnest Gaines. Mr. Gaines requested that his tax be cut since he returned them to high. After discussion the council agreed to leave the tax as returned

There being no other business Mr. David made a motion to adjourn seconded by Mr Bickinson voted on and passed.
