City Council Met in regular session at the City Hall at 7:30 pm. Mayor Lawrence was absent and all other members of the Council answered present.

The meeting was opened with prayer by Chief of Police Crawford Hayes.

Mr. Jerry King of Fox-King Tractor Company was present and wanted to sell the city some new Mowing machine equipment. Mr. King pointed out the advantages of the new sickle-bar mower and stated that the mower would cost \$400.00. After discussion Mr. David made a motion to turn this matter over to the parks committee and have them give a report at the next meeting. seconded by Mr. Woods voted on and passed.

Mr. Dickinson made a motion to issue fifa on all property with deliquent accounts due the city. After discussion Mr. Dickinson withdrew his motion.

Mr. David reported that the week of Sept. 9-14 would be Civil Defense week and ~~stated~~ that he would appreciate the cooperation of the city officials and that he would post notices in the local papers of the happings.

Mr. Edwards reported that the new water tank would be in operation within a week and that the addition at the filter plant would be ready for operation within two to three weeks.

Mr. McDaniel stated to the council that the Atlanta Gas Company had been cutting the city streets without proper permission. He suggested a tighter control. After discussion Mr. Dickinson made a motion that anyone wishing to install underground pipe, wires, etc., must furnish a sketch of the job and get written approval from the clerk's office to cross any city street. Any violator would be subject to a \$200.00 fine and sixty days in jail of both. This motion seconded by Mr. Woods voted on and passed.

Mr. Woods instructed Chief Hayes to look into the crowded situation existing on College Street in front of the grammar shhool. Also check the possibility of getting some school boy patrols.

Chief Fred Stephens of the Fire Dept. reported that the radio had been installed in the fire truck and was working fine.

The City Council approved a Holiday for city employees on Labor Day.

No other business Mr. David made a motion to adjourn seconded by Mr. Dickinson voted on and passed.
