
City Council met in regular session July 9, 1956 at 7:30 pm with all members present except alderman J.T. Wood Jr. who was away with the National Guard.

Mayor Lawrence opened the meeting with prayer.

1. Mr. David stated to the council that he thought all members of the Garbage detail that was involved in the accident on King Street and on West Elm Street should be fired or reprimanded. Mayor Lawrence stated that he had already looked into the matter.
2. A delegation from the Junior Woman's Club was present and wanted to know the exact story on the basement of the Civic Center. They wanted to know if they would have full control of the basement and who would pay for the lights, water, heat. Mr. David made a motion to give the Junior Woman's Club full control of the basement and the City would pay for the utilities until decided otherwise. This motion seconded by Mr. Dickinson voted on and passed.
3. The yard in back of the Civic Center discussed. The Club members stated that a nursery had been discussed but no final action had been taken. They wanted to know if the City would build a fence around the lot if they decided on a nursery. No action taken at this time.
4. Mr. David stated that he wanted to use the Civic Center on July 24 for a meeting on Cancer. He was granted this permission.
5. Mr. Edwards stated that Mrs. Pass wanted the dirt removed from in front of her house. Also that the utility pole at the corner of Maple and South Wall Streets needed replacing.
6. Mayor Lawrence stated that he had given the First Federal Savings and Loan Association a proposition for a loan on the Civic Center Building.
7. Action on the City obtaining power from the Clark Hill Project was delayed at this time.
8. Awnings for the house of Mrs. Boblett discussed. Stated to the Clerk to inform Mrs. Boblett that the Trees that were cut were on City Property and that the City would not put up any awnings for her a shade.
9. The Council decided to Meet Wednesday July 18 to work on taxes.

Alderman David Made a motion to adjourn as there were no other business to come before the council at this time. Seconded by Mr. Dickinson voted on and passed.
