June 25, 1956

City Council met in regular session at the City Hall Monday, June 25, 1956 at 7:30 P.M. with all members present.

Meeting opened with prayer by Mayor Lawrence.

Mayor Lawrence expressed that the City Council was glad to have alderman Wood back at the Council meeting after an operation.

A delegation from the Nickelsville Road was present and asked that water be run in that direction as far as the Elk's Club. Stated that most of the wells were dry and they were in bad need of water. The City Engineer stated that it was approximately 8,976 feet from the 41 highway to the cross road at the Elk's Club. Mayor Lawrence explained to the delegation that the water fund was depleted at this time and since there were only 17 customers on this route signed for water ~~at this time~~, there was no chance for the City to run water out this route at this time.

Mr. Edwards reported that the drain problem at the home of Roy Pass had been worked out satisfactorily.

Mr. Edwards instructed the City Engineer to see if the street sweeper could be rerouted to keep it off highway 41 during the daytime. Also to place flambo's out when patching streets.

Mr. Edwards reported that Mr. Travis Powell wanted the storm drain fixed through his property on North Wall Street. *Instructed City Engineer to look into situation.*

Chief Hayes brought before the Council the problem of parking in front of Davis Brothers on the opposite side of the street. Residents in this neighborhood complaining that all parking places are taken and they have no place to park. After discussion it was decided to let the Chief ask the residents if they would be in favor of parking meters as this seemed the only solution to the problem.

Chief Hayes also brought before the Council the noise problem from prisoners in jail. Stated they were keeping the neighborhood awake at night. No solution at this time.

Chief Hayes stated that Mr. Massingill was going to summer camp for two weeks and that he was taking one of these weeks for his vacation and he would pay someone to work in his place the other week.

Mayor Lawrence brought up right of way deeds on ~~the~~ Line Street and decided to put the Street Committee in charge of obtaining these deeds. After discussion it was decided to get all property owners together and put the story to them. If they wanted the new street they would sign the deeds if not no street. July 10th was the deadline for obtaining these deeds.

There being no other business Mr. David made motion to adjourn seconded by Mr. Dickinson voted on and passed.
