


April 9, 1956  
Calhoun, Georgia

1. City Council met in regular session on Monday April 9, 1956 at 7:30 pm with all members present except Mayor Lawrence who was out of town on business.
2. The meeting was opened with the Council repeating the Lord's Prayer.
3. Mayor Lawrence was absent and Mayor Protem Hoyt Edwards served over the Council meeting.
4. ~~Minutes~~ Minutes of the previous meeting read and adopted.
5. The curb and gutter in front of the property of Col. Erwin on Trammell Street and the Haney property on College Street was discussed. The City engineer stated that work was to start to clear this situation as soon as possible.
6. Alderman Dickinson made a suggestion that the council, mayor and clerk attend church services at the Baptist Church on Friday night of this week.
7. Mr. David stated that the people on Happy Top are asking for Curb and Gutter and that they have had their petition in for 1½ years. City Council agrees that this work will start as soon as funds are available.
8. New man for filter plant discussed. City Engineer makes a suggestion that the city approach Mr. Holt and Mr. Johnston and ask them if they will work 10 hours per day and the pay to be worked out if possible. This would do away with the 3rd shift man. Mr. McDaniel feels that when the new plant is completed that two shifts will be sufficient.
9. Mr. Edwards states that Mr. E.T. Shepherd is unhappy because the city has turned water on his lot on Wander street. Mr. Shepherd wants the city to fill in the lot and stop the drainage from coming on him. After discussion the council decided to let Mr. Edwards contact Mr. Shepherd and see what could be worked out.
10. There being no other business Mr. David made motion to adjourn seconded by Mr. Dickinson voted on and passed.
