City Council met in regular session at the city hall with all members present.

Alderman Frank M. Dickinson opened the meeting with prayer.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read by the clerk and approved by the council.

Mr. Ellis Woods, president of the Plainville Development Corporation, was present at the meeting. Mr. Woods ask that the mayor and council give some consideration to lowering the bill in the amount of \$893.00 rendered to the Plainville Development Corporation by the City of Calhoun for lowering a water main at the Trend Mill plant in Plainville. Mr. Woods stated that he had talked with city supt. James Owens about the project before it was started and that Mr. Owens estimated that the job would cost approximately \$500.00. Mr. Woods stated he felt that the machinery charge on the bill should be lifted since it was a benefit to the City of Calhoun to help out the citizens of Plainville. After discussion the council agreed to make the total of the bill rendered a flat \$500.00.

City Supt. James Owens had an estimate on paving, curb and gutter, sewer pipe, and a sidewalk for Pitts Street. The cost of the entire project would be approximately \$1,625.00. After discussion alderman Norton made a motion that the above work be done on Pitts Street. This motion received a second from alderman Dickinson was voted on and passed.

A bill in the amount of \$81.00 to Forrest Mills, Inc. for a fire plug was discussed at this time. There was some question as to wheather the mill should be charged for this plug since it was the property of the city. After discussion alderman David made a motion to consider the bill paid. This motion was seconded by alderman Dickinson voted on and passed.

Mr. Verlon Dixon made a request to the council for the extension of the water main to his property along the Dew's Pond Road. The council instructed Mr. Owens to check into the distance and see if anything could be worked out for the residents in this proposed area.

Alderman Dickinson made a motion that an ordinance be passed adopting the Southern Standard Building Code, Southern Standard Building Code Part III Plumbing, and the National Electrical Code for the City of Calhoun. This motion received a second from alderman David and was voted on and passed. The ordinance would go into effect as soon as the city attorney could draw the ordinance and work out the details to make it legal.

There being no other business the meeting was adjourned.
