City Council met in regular session at the city hall with the following members present: Mayor Frank Dickinson--Aldermen Woods, David, King and Lewis.

Mayor Dickinson opened the meeting with prayer.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read by the Clerk and approved by the council.

Mr. Schultz of the Housing and Home Finance Agency was present at the request of the City of Calhoun. The city is interested in additional public housing and requested the Housing and Home Finance Agency to send a representative to the council meeting to explain the Workable Program which was the first step necessary toward acquiring additional public housing. Mr. Boyd of the local housing authority and Mr. Cohen of an Atlanta architect firm were also present at the meeting. After discussion the council agreed to go ahead with the Workable Program and the other steps necessary to acquire additional housing.

The Home Life Insurance Co., The Pilot Insurance Co., American Health Insurance Company and Gulf Life Insurance Company had representatives present in the interest of a new group insurance plan for the employee's of the city. After discussion Mayor Dickinson stated to the representatives that sealed bids would be received at the June 18th meeting on the plan outlined by the Home Life Insurance Company. Mayor Dickinson stated the plan would be decided on at this date.

Earnest Phillips, a colored citizen of the city applied for a beer license at an Alexander Street address. Mayor Dickinson referred the application to Alderman Jerry King, Chairman of the License Committee, for action at the next meeting.

A petition by 100% of the property owners on Bunea Vista Drive requesting curb and gutter for their street was read by Mayor Dickinson. After discussion Alderman King made a motion that an estimate be made of the cost of curb and gutter plus cost of driveways and property owners be informed of this cost and as soon as money was deposited with the city clerk work should begin as soon as possible. This motion received a second from Alderman Lewis was voted on and passed.

City Council agreed to install a 1" water line to the new proposed maintenance building at the local guard property at no cost to the building contractor or the State of Georgia.

Supt. James S. Owens stated to the council that the new regulators had been installed at the substation on North Wall Street and the concession building at the baseball field was in the process of being built.
