1. Mayor Palmer called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone.
2. Mayor Palmer opened the discussion concerning the one agenda item consisting of an adoption resolution for the Five Year Community Work Program.
3. Mr. Peterson gave an overview of the City of Calhoun Five Year Community Work Program which is included within the Calhoun Comprehensive Plan 2007-2027. The process is needed for Calhoun to remain a Qualified Local Government. The City completed the five year update and submitted it to the Northwest Regional Commission (NWGRC) who then submitted it to the Georgia Department of Community Affairs (DCA). DCA required a few minor adjustments that were implemented into the five year update and then subsequently approved the update.
4. David Howerin representing the NWGRC stated that the City needed to pass an adoption resolution to complete the process. Also, once the resolution was submitted that the City should receive a letter from DCA confirming its Qualified Local Government status.
5. Mayor Palmer read the adoption resolution for the City of Calhoun Five Year Community Work Program Update for years 2013-2017 to the local comprehensive plan. (resolution and work program document attached)
6. Councilman Hammond made a motion to approve the adoption resolution. Councilman Crowley gave a second with all voting aye, motion approved.
7. Councilman Hammond made a motion to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Councilman Crowley with all voting aye, motion approved.
