

JULY 10, 1972 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of the June 12 meeting read and approved.
3. Council welcomed city lineman Billy Lackey, seriously injured on April 21, to the meeting.
4. Council adopted a resolution authorizing Tom B. David to submit an application to the Federal Aviation Administration for an "Airport Master Planning Grant" for Tom B. David Airport and also naming Mr. David to act as liaison in all matters relating to the "Airport Master Plan".
5. Ald. Padgett heard in regard to delinquent taxes. Council instructed the clerk to sell the property of delinquent tax payers.
6. Ald. David said that F. D. Duffey had requested a water tap on Lovers' Lane Road. Supt. Owens advised that all he need do is pay for the tap.
7. Ald. Cox reported that J. Ralston was experiencing some difficulty with his sanitary sewer. Water & Sewer Supt. Bowman to handle.
8. Ald. Cox said he has received several compliments on the dog pound.
9. Mrs. John L. (Ginny) Reese explained that the Calhoun-Gordon County Volunteer Water Safety Program had an excellent chance to win in the group division of "The National Volunteer Awards Contest" and asked the Council to nominate this group. This was done following a motion to adopt a resolution by Ald. David and Ald. Cox.
10. Charles Williams Real Estate Investment Corp. requested the Council to adopt a resolution confirming the need for additional housing here, but it was postponed until the July 24 meeting.
11. Ald. Padgett moved to accept the low bid of Taylor Iron Works & Supply Co. to erect a 300,000 gallon standpipe near Antioch Church for \$46,375.00. Ald. David 2nd and the motion was voted on and passed.
12. Supt. Owens heard in regard to extending sanitary sewer service to Milton Stewart's property. Ald. David moved to postpone any action, 2nd by Ald. Padgett and passed with Ald. Collins voting against the motion.
13. Ald. Cox moved, at Supt. Owens request, to grant Mr. Owens a 3 or 4 week leave of absence without pay. Ald. David 2nd and the motion was approved.
14. Mr. J. C. Boyd reported a dilapidated house and junk autos at 235 Mill St. Mayor Dickinson instructed Supt. Owens to inspect and condemn, if warranted.
15. Council ordered the Ira Mason houses on Wilson St. condemned.
16. Ald. Collins expressed his gratitude to the Fire Dept. for the excellent job in extinguishing a fire recently at Garren Const.
17. Mayor Dickinson and the board of aldermen complimented Mr. & Mrs. Allen B. Roff for picking up litter on S. Piedmont and Hicks Sts.
18. Ald. David moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Padgett and done.
