

AUG. 28, 1972 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.


1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of the Aug. 14 meeting read and approved.
3. Ald. Cox moved to grant Donald L. Jacks a license for a pool room with coin operated tables and Billy Talley a license for a taxi stand with 3 cabs. Ald. Collins 2nd and the motion was approved.
4. Ald. David nominated Mrs. Edna Langford for woman of the year in the contest sponsored by the Business & Professional Women's Club. Ald. Cox seconded the nomination and it was unanimously approved. Mayor Dickinson appointed Ald. David to see that the necessary information in support of the nomination is forwarded to the club.
5. Ald. David said the local Civil Defense Unit wishes to sponsor a country music show on Nov. 10 and moved that the license be waived. Ald. Padgett seconded the motion and it was approved.
6. Council discussed the school budget and Ald. David moved to appropriate the \$375,000.00 requested by the City Board of Education. Ald. Padgett 2nd and the motion was voted on and passed.
7. Supt. Owens announced that R. M. Dobbs, CPA had completed the special audit on the water and sewer accounts from July 1, 1971 to July 1, 1972 and added that the city needs a new raw water pumping station and 2 two-million gallon reservoirs. Ald. David 1 moved to proceed with the plans, 2nd by Ald. Cox and approved.
8. Supt. Owens advised that the water supply is critical and that Venture Carpets and Aldon Carpet Finishing were asked to curtail operations last week as a result.
9. Supt. Owens said that Lewis Bailey had asked for electric service for a mobile home on W. Line St. and that the city would have to go to considerable expense to provide this service. Ald. David moved that this expenditure not be made since the lot on which Mr. Bailey intended to locate the trailer is in violation of the zoning ordinance. Ald. Collins and the motion was approved.
10. Ald. David moved to pay the Coosa Valley APDC dues, 2nd by Ald. Cox and approved.
11. Clerk heard in regard to request of R. F. Chance and/or C. B. David for quit claim deed to 10 x 55 ft. plot in Chandler Cemetery.
12. Clerk read petition for annexation of property of Helen Jones, (C. M. Jones Estate), and it was accepted on motion of Ald. Cox and Ald. Collins.
13. Ald. Padgett moved to enroll Supt. Owens, Asst. Supt. Fox and Water Supt. Bowman in the Georgia Water Pollution Control Ass'n. and the Water Pollution Control Federation; 2nd by Ald. Collins and passed.
14. Water & Sewer Supt. Bowman said the manhole requested by Mr. Boyd for the housing project will be built as soon as he can work it into his schedule.
15. Ald. David moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Cox and done.
