

JUNE 12, 1972 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of the May 22 meeting read and approved.
3. Council instructed the clerk to give those delinquent with business licenses 24 hour notices before issuing warrants.
4. Ald. Cox moved to charge 50% penalty on all licenses and permits not voluntarily purchased; 2nd by Ald. Padgett and passed.
5. Supt. Owens said he had been advised by the city's consulting engineer, Bill Greene, that the requested increase in the grant for the sewerage treatment plant should be approved soon.
6. Ald. Cox moved to annex the property of Kuhlman Construction Co. on Industrial Boulevard, 2nd by Ald. Collins and passed.
7. Elec. Supt. Bell said a larger transformer had been installed at sub-station 2 and we should have better service.
8. Asst. Supt. Fox said a representative of HUD is coming to inspect our workable program.
9. Mr. Fox heard in regard to Marvin Tate and Darrell Scoggins wishing to annex their residences, but not their chicken houses. Mr. Fox admitted that the property is not contiguous to the city unless the chicken houses are included, therefore the request had to be denied.
10. Asst. Supt. Fox reported that James Beamer has not yet given an easement to cross his property with the sanitary sewer main to Milton Stewart's proposed housing development near Modern Maid Homes.
11. Water & Sewer Supt. Bowman recommended water taps be made for M. M. Hall off the Sugar Valley Road and N. B. Ellis on Dan Cheri Drive. Council approved following motion of Ald. Padgett and second of Ald. Cox.
12. Ald. Padgett announced that the merchants in the Gordon Hills Shopping Center are very complimentary of the Police Department for ridding the shopping center of a group of loiterers and potential trouble makers.
13. Ald. David moved to adjourn; 2nd by Ald. Padgett and done.
