



OCT. 12, 1970 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH MAYOR DICKINSON, ALDERMEN WOODS, HOLLAND AND COX PRESENT, ALD. DAVID ABSENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of the regular meeting of Sept. 28 and a special meeting of Oct. 1 read and approved.
3. John Slagle, DonWilliams and Co. School Supt. Wayne Ashworth requested Council to extend water to Red Bud School. Mr. Williams estimated they will add 50 houses by next spring if water is made available and Supt. Ashworth said he would sign a contract guaranteeing the city \$100.00 per month or \$50.00 per month more than the actual amount billed. Council advised they would have an answer at the Oct. 26 meeting.
4. Ald. Holland stated that Mr. W. A. Shirley had again asked the city to open a street from W. Line north to connect with N. King. Supt. Owens said there is no easement on record indicating that L. A. Roach agreed for a street to cross his property.
5. Ald. Holland inquired as to status of Oothcaloga St. project. Supt. Owens advised that the State Highway Dept. is accepting bids on the property in conflict with construction until Nov. 4.
6. Ald. Woods announced that Section CC in Fain Cemetery is now open.
7. At Ald. Woods suggestion, Council agreed to have the sexton's house and shop repainted.
8. Ald. Woods reported that the 16" water main will be connected to the pump next week-end.
9. Ald. Woods said city residents should be reminded that it is illegal to burn leaves and rubbish. Council agreed to place an ad in the local papers.
10. Ald. Woods moved that the city correct a surface drainage problem for Friendship Baptist Church with the church paying for the pipe. Ald. Cox seconded and the motion was approved.
11. Water & Light Supt. Bell said he had received complaints that the contractor laying the sewer line to Industrial Boulevard was negligent in repairing fences.
12. Raymond Ross' property on Dan Cheri Drive was annexed by petition on motion of Ald. Holland and Cox.
13. Ald. Woods moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Holland and done.
