

AUG. 24, 1970 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.


1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of Aug. 10 meeting read and approved.
3. Bill Avery, representing the Joint Municipal Employees Retirement System of the Georgia Municipal Association, discussed with the Council the JMERS program. Mayor Dickinson appointed Ald. Holland, Supt. Owens and the city clerk as a committee to study and recommend a retirement plan for the city.
4. Council approved plans for the additional units of the Housing Authority subject to the changes made by the building inspector and water and light superintendent on motion of Ald. David and second of Ald. Woods.
5. Ald. Woods suggested disposing of the old reservoir site and the former site of the garbage dump. No action taken.
6. Supt. Owens advised that James Thomason, et al., have requested extension of city water main to their property on Amakanata Rd. No action taken.
7. Supt. Owens heard in regard to purchasing balance of lot for the two million gallon reservoir from T. C. Owens. Council approved the purchase on motion of Ald. Woods and second of Ald. David.
8. The property of Robert Dillard on Rome Rd., Billy Causby on W. Belmont and B. J. Wilson on N. Wall was annexed by petition following motion of Ald. Holland and Ald. Cox.
9. Asst. Supt. Roy Fox and the clerk were authorized to negotiate a settlement with Edgbert Black for damages to his property in the extension of the sanitary sewer main to Industrial Blvd.
10. Ald. Woods moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. David and done.
