

JUNE 29 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT.


1. Ald. Holland delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of the meeting of June 8 read and approved.
3. John Slagle and Don Williams requested Council to extend the water main to serve Red Bud. Council instructed Supt. Owens to determine the cost and advise.
4. Council received a petition signed by 18 residents east of Resaca requesting prompt action in improving the water service to this area. Supt. Owens estimated it will be 30 days before delivery and installation of a pump can be effected to improve water service to this area.
5. Ald. David heard in the matter of detergents in our water and the resulting unpleasant taste. Mr. David suggested the Council seriously consider using water from Amakanata in the high pressure system.
6. Ald. Cox heard in reference to increasing the width of Chandler St. between Pisgah Way and Woodlawn.
7. Ald. Cox heard in regard to an increase in wages. Mayor Dickinson stated that he would call an executive session to consider this.
8. Ald. Holland inquired as to the status of the Oothcaloga St. project. Supt. Owens suggested a letter to State Highway Director Jim Gillis.
9. Ald. Holland advised by Supt. Owens that the street to the new recreation area was ready for surfacing.
10. Supt. Owens presented petitions for annexation of property on Industrial Boulevard. Ald. Woods moved to accept, 2nd by Ald. David and approved.
11. Mayor Dickinson signed the new contract with Southeastern Power Administration.
12. Ald. David moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Woods and done.
