


FEB. 9, 1970 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of the Jan. 26 meeting read and approved.
3. Ald. Woods suggested that the pickup truck formerly used by the meter readers be left at the water filtration plant for the use of the operators; Council approved.
4. Ald. Woods, noting that the city has not been paid for the opening and closing of several graves, offered a motion that the funeral directors be placed on a cash basis and given until April 1 to pay their indebtedness to the city. Ald. David seconded and the motion was voted on and passed.
5. Ald. David said Mrs. Flora Shivers had complained that the city had relocated a street light that was in front of her house and asked that one be installed. No action was taken since Mrs. Shivers property is outside the city limits.
6. Ald. David moved the adoption of the recreation resolution; Ald. Cox seconded, and the motion was approved.
7. Ald. David moved that the '63 Ford truck, declared surplus by the Water Dept., be given to the Vocational Technical School. Ald. Holland seconded the motion and it was approved.
8. Ald. David offered the motion to delete a paragraph in Contract "B" of the sewer system improvement which will allow a sub-contractor to install the sewer main to Industrial Boulevard. This motion was seconded by Ald. Woods and approved.
9. Supt. Owens said Gold Kist Mills had complained about the sprinkler standby charge. Ald. Woods and Ald. David moved to leave the charge as is and Council agreed.
10. Robert T. Blaylock's property on West Drive was accepted by petition on motion of Ald. David and Woods and Council approval.
11. Supt. Owens and the clerk appointed to negotiate with county officials on ad valorem taxes for 1970 on Industrial Blvd.
12. Ald. David moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Holland and done,
