

JUNE 8, 1970 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH MAYOR DICKINSON, ALD. DAVID, WOODS AND COX PRESENT; ALD. HOLLAND ABSENT.


1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of May 25 meeting read and approved.
3. The sprinkler stand-by charge was discussed, but no action taken.
4. Council agreed to postpone the June 22 meeting until June 29 because of the GMA Convention at Jekyll Island, June 21, 22, 23.
5. Mayor Dickinson reported that the shopping center owners had begun to correct the hazardous condition on the embankment between their property and Victory Drive.
6. Ald. Woods requested the Water Dept. to lower the main to J. B. Worley, et al north of Resaca to prevent freezing again.
7. Wayne Hall advised Council that he had arranged with John Stanfield and Sons to pave the streets in Briarwood S/D and requested city to install sanitary sewer mains prior to the paving. Mayor Dickinson quoted the city ordinance pertaining to sanitary sewer construction and, after discussion, Ald. Woods offered a motion that Mr. Hall pay for the pipe and be re-imbursed at the rate of \$100.00 per tap. Ald. David 2nd and the motion was approved.
8. Ald. David heard in the matter of on street parking on McConnell Road. No action.
9. Council approved a resolution (copy attached) authorizing the Executive Committee of the Power Section of the Georgia Municipal Association to act as the city's agent and attorney-in-fact in all matters relative to the rate filing of Georgia Power Co. pending before the Federal Power Commission.
10. Water & Light Supt. Jack Bell announced that most of the material and equipment necessary for the improvements to the electrical system had been delivered.
11. Ald. Woods moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. David and done.
