

AUGUST 8, 1966 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT  
EXCEPT ALD. J. T. WOODS, JR.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of July 25 meeting read and approved.
3. Claude Nichols and Billy W. Scoggins were present and requested Council to build a retaining wall on the west and south sides of the property belonging to the L. M. Nichols Estate at River and W. Line Sts. They also asked that the lot be filled to the level of the street and plant mixed paved. Council advised Messrs. Nichols and Scoggins to acquire cost figures and make them available at the Aug. 22 meeting. (Ref. Contract 7/6/56)
4. Ald. King advised that he plans to propose an increase in personnel for the Police Dept.
5. The clerk suggested that the old tax digest be used for property tax collections for 1966 with an increase in the millage rate, if necessary, rather than risking involvement in litigation and delayed mailing of notices awaiting Hunnicutt & Associates' revaluation program completion. Council preferred to use Hunnicutt's figures.
6. Ald. King moved to adjourn, seconded by Ald. Norton, voted and done.
