

SEPT. 12, 1966 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL, ALL MEMBERS PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance introduced Rev. Al Turnell, pastor of the New Echota Methodist Church, who gave the invocation.
2. Minutes of August 22 meeting read and approved.
3. Ald. Woods moved to permit Beamer Gin to operate for three months (Oct, Nov, Dec) on the special gin rate. Ald. David seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
4. Ald. Woods heard in the matter of Robert Acree's property. Ald. King said to advise Mr. Acree that the City would clean these lots next week. Council agreed.
5. Ald. David asked for quiet zone signs to be placed near the Keever residence on Trammell St. due to an illness in the family.
6. Clerk read a letter from City School Supt. Gus Cate thanking the officials for the improvements to the streets and grounds in the vicinity of the schools.
7. Council authorized the publication of a legal notice of the intent to re-zone several lots in the Garden Hills Subdivision from R-1 to R-2. Public hearing to be held at the Council meeting Oct. 10.
8. The City's group insurance program was discussed but no action taken.
9. Ald. King reported the fire hall re-modeling was 60% complete and the new fire truck was expected Dec. 31. Mr. King further stated that the Fire Dept. was continuing their record keeping and building a reservoir of trained volunteers.
10. Ald. King moved to adjourn; Ald. David seconded and the meeting was adjourned.
