

FEB. 14 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT EXCEPT  
ALD. J. T. WOODS, JR.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance opened the meeting with prayer.
2. Minutes of Jan. 31 meeting read and approved.
3. Mr. Jim Williams, manager of Atlanta Gas Light Company's local office, and Mr. Frank Hibbets, a company vice president from Rome were present to discuss renewal of the company's franchise. Mr. Hibbets advised Council that the city's proposal was not acceptable to his company. He said that Calhoun was receiving the maximum amount paid by his company to any city and they could not pay a higher rate nor could they pay any amount on heavy commercial or industrial users. Council advised Mr. Hibbets that they would discuss the matter again at a mutually agreed upon time.
4. Ald. King reported that he and Supt. Owens and Fire Chief Hyde had a fruitful visit with Mr. Cecil Jones of SE Underwriters in Atlanta. Mr. King said they were advised that to obtain a class 6 insurance rate, it would be necessary to train 5 additional volunteer firemen, buy a new 750 gpm pumper and purchase about 1200 ft. of hose. Mr. Jones said it would also be necessary to adopt a fire prevention code.
5. Resolution from Gordon Co. Chamber of Commerce praising local law enforcement was read and ordered spread upon the minutes.
6. Ald. King moved to adjourn, Ald. David seconded and the meeting was adjourned.
