
1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of Nov. 14 meeting read and approved.
3. Mr. Roy Davis of Roy Davis Chevrolet-Oldsmobile, Inc., told the Council that due to a misunderstanding over a penalty on a water and light bill, the city had ceased doing business with him. He said he appreciated the business he had done with the city in the past and would like to get it back. Council advised Mr. Davis that he could expect "city Business" immediately.
4. Ald. Norton said he wished to commend the Electric Dept. for a job well done on the Christmas Decorations.
5. Ald. Norton heard in regard to the terrible aroma emanating from the Azalea Meat packing plant. Supt. Owens to see Mr. Kea for solution to the problem.
6. Supt. Owens reported that the pump should be installed on the water main to Sugar Valley in two weeks.
7. Clerk told Council of Dr. R. D. Walter's request to change traffic light at Pine and River Sts. to flash caution (instead of stop and go) in the late evenings and early morns. Council decided to leave as is in the interests of safety.
8. The proposed parking lot between Court and Oothcaloga east of railroad was discussed briefly.
9. Ald. Norton suggested that the City Attorney write the Gov. in hopes of getting a long term lease on the above park.
10. Ald. Woods moved to adjourn, Ald. Norton seconded the motion and Mayor Dickinson declared the meeting adjourned.
