


JULY 25, 1966 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH MAYOR FRANK M. DICKINSON, ALDERMEN TOM B. DAVID, W. R. NORTON AND J. T. WOODS, JR. PRESENT, ALD. A. J. KING ABSENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance opened the meeting with the reading of verses 11 thru 19 of the 11th chapter of St. Mathew.
2. Minutes of July 11 meeting read and approved.
3. Ald. Woods said it appeared that a pump would have to be installed to provide water users north of Resaca with adequate pressure and volume. Mr. Woods asked status of two proposed water main extensions involving railroad right of way crossings north end of Industrial Blvd. to US 41 at Damascus Church and at junction of US 41 N and SR 225 to John W. Jones. Mr. Owens said they were being processed.
4. Ald. David sought and received Council approval for the City Supt. and City Clerk to accompany him to the dedication of the Newman-Coweta Col Airport on July 27.
5. Supt. Owens said Mr. Robert Acree was proceeding satisfactorily with the removal of his sub-standard buildings in the city.
6. Clerk read letter from Mrs. Mary Gregory Jewett, Executive Secretary of the Georgia Historical Commission, requesting water at New Echota. Council advised their position was unchanged, i. e., to share the \$2,800 estimated cost equally.
7. Ald. Norton moved to adjourn, Ald. Woods seconded and the meeting was declared adjourned by Mayor Dickinson.
